

ROBIN RANDALL MEMORIAL TRUST POLICY DOCUMENT

1. Definition

- a. TDCC-means the Taita Districts Cricket Clun Inc
- b. **Chairperson** means the Trustee who is the chairperson of the trust appointed pursuant to clause 3 c
- c. Trustees Gary Renold Gosper, David John Gillespie, Mark Houghton
- d. **Funds** means the funds and property of the trust, weather raised by subscription, grant, donation, or sponsorship.
- e. Objectives- means the objectives of the trust as outlined in clause 2
- f. Trust means Robin Randall Memorial Trust
- g. **Trustee** means the person, or persons who for the time being hold the position of trustee having been appointed to the position at the TDCC AGM

2. Aim and Objective of the Trust

a. The trustee shall apply the funds as they think for or towards anyone or more of the following exclusive objectives. always noting a minimum balance of the initial bequest shall remain in the trust fund.

[1] To provide financial assistance for an identified talented college student to attend University, with a maximum payment to each individual \$1000 per year and on the condition that, the player commits to Taita for two seasons.

[2] To contribute in part, individual for the Cricket gear sponsorship to a member of the Taita Premier Squad who is in the Firebirds Pathway system

[3] To aid with talented college players or members of the Taita Cricket club to attend specific coaching sessions that will benefit both the player and the club.

[4] To provide fiscal assistance for talented members of the Premier Squad to play cricket offshore in the off season.

[5] To purchase specified cricket training equipment that would benefit the development of cricket players in the local colleges or Taita Cricket Club

b. The trustees shall raise funds for the Trust via

[1] specific donations made by members to the Robin Randall Memorial Trust[2] specified donations made by members of the Titanium club to the Trust as part of their membership of the Titanium club.

[3] interest accrued from investment of Trust funds in the TDCC Westpac Managed funds account.

3. Appointment of Trustees

- a. Number of trustees three but no more than five
- b. Appointment of trustees- the appointment of the trustees will take place at the TDCC AGM, with the TDCC current committee endorsing the nominations in advance of the AGM
- c. Chair the Trustees will appoint a Chairperson.
- d. Term of office All trustees will hold office until the next TDCC AGM.
- e. Treasurer The Treasurer shall be the TDCC Treasurer.

4. Removal of Trustee

a. a trustee can be removed by vote at a special TDCC AGM, with at least 14 days' notice, and definitive reasons for the removal, with the trustee having the opportunity to reply at the meeting to consider the removal.

5. Advisory Trustee

- a. The trustees may appoint or consult advisory trustee, when deciding of a person that warrants consideration for a grant at any time.
- b. The advisory trustee/s will not form part of the voting quorum.

6. Meeting of Trustee

- a. The trust shall meet at minimum quarterly face to face, email or by video conference.
- b. minutes shall be taken for all meetings.

7. Majority Decision

a. Majority vote with minimum of three trustees voting.

8. Power of trustees

- a. The trustees will only dispense income the trust has attained above the initial bequeath over time.
- b. The trustees will look to grow and enhance the trust funds.
- c. To invest funds in the trust as appropriate. The investment of funds should follow a low/medium risk strategy.
- d. maintain true and correct accounts at are validated by the TDCC Treasurer.
- e. The main aim of the Trust investment strategy is around the preservation of capital. Investments should therefore follow a low/medium risk strategy. Namely, but not limited to, Fixed Interest products and/or Managed Funds".

9. Indemnity

a. Non trustee sha be liable for any loss other than the loss attributed to personal dishonesty.

10. Application for grant funds

- a. an application for grant funds can be made to the Trust by
 - [1] TDCC Committee

[2] Individual TDCC players, these nominations are authorized by the TDCC committee.

[3] College students, nominations authorized by the TDCC committee that met the criteria set out in clause 2 a [1]

11. Alternations to the constitution

a. The constitution and rules can be altered by the trustees by way of resolution at the TDCC AGM
