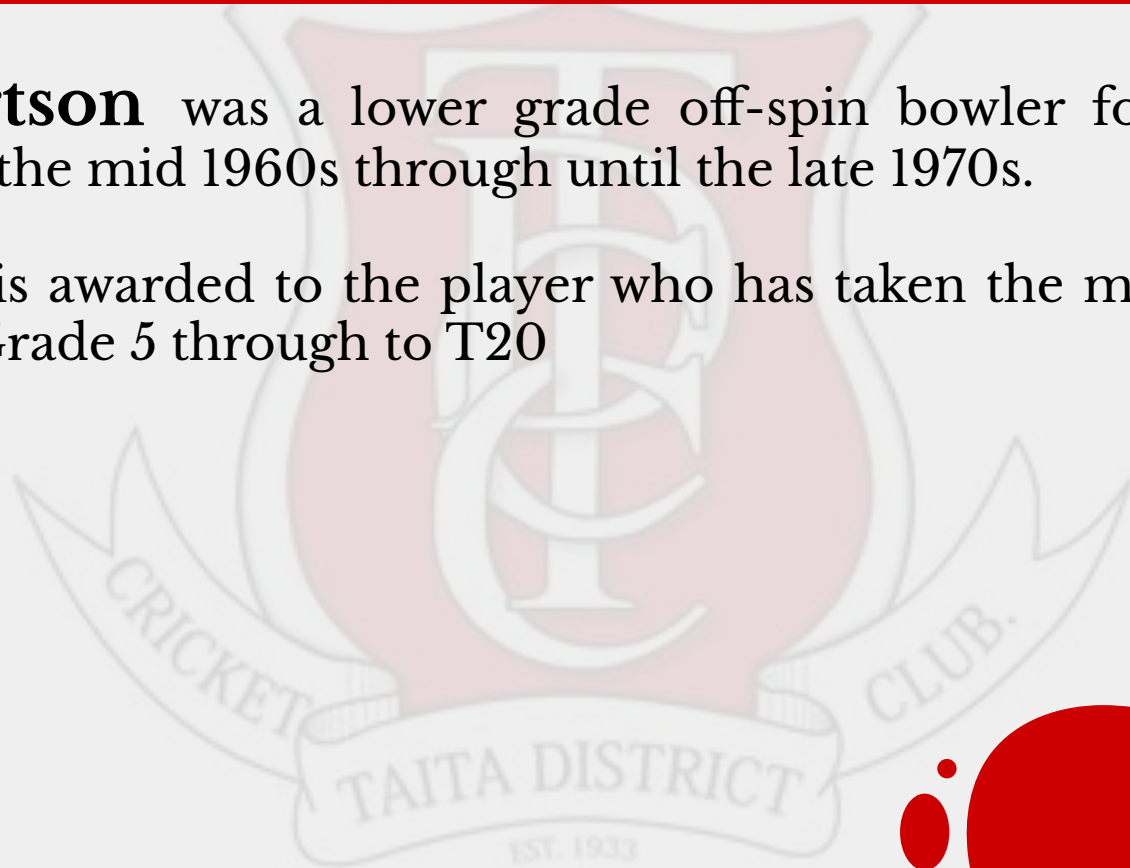


GJ ROBERTSON TROPHY

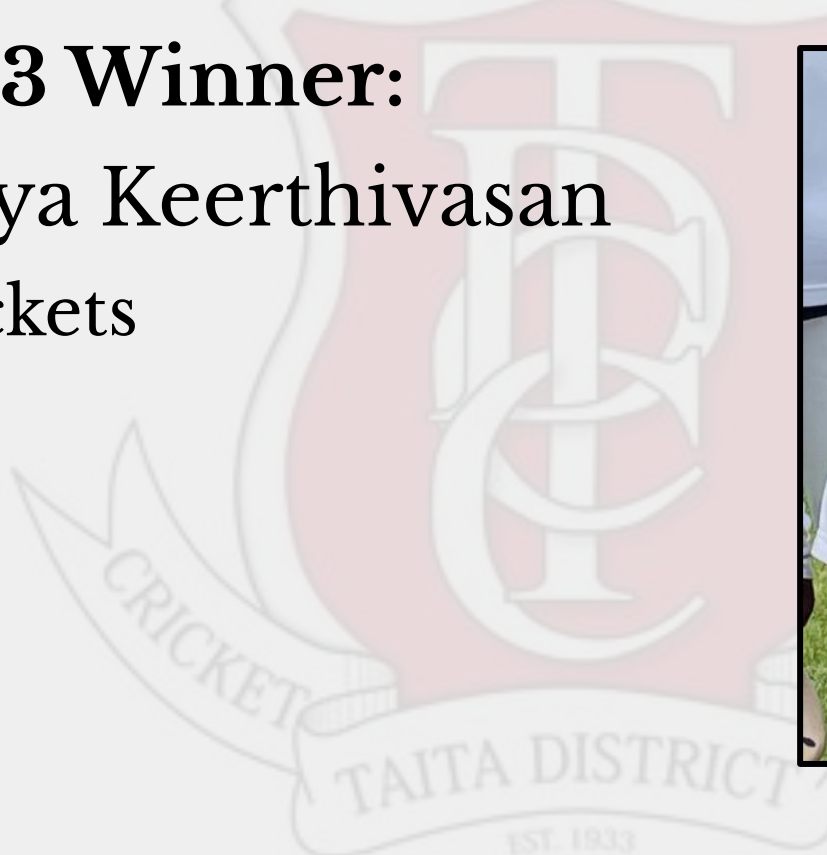

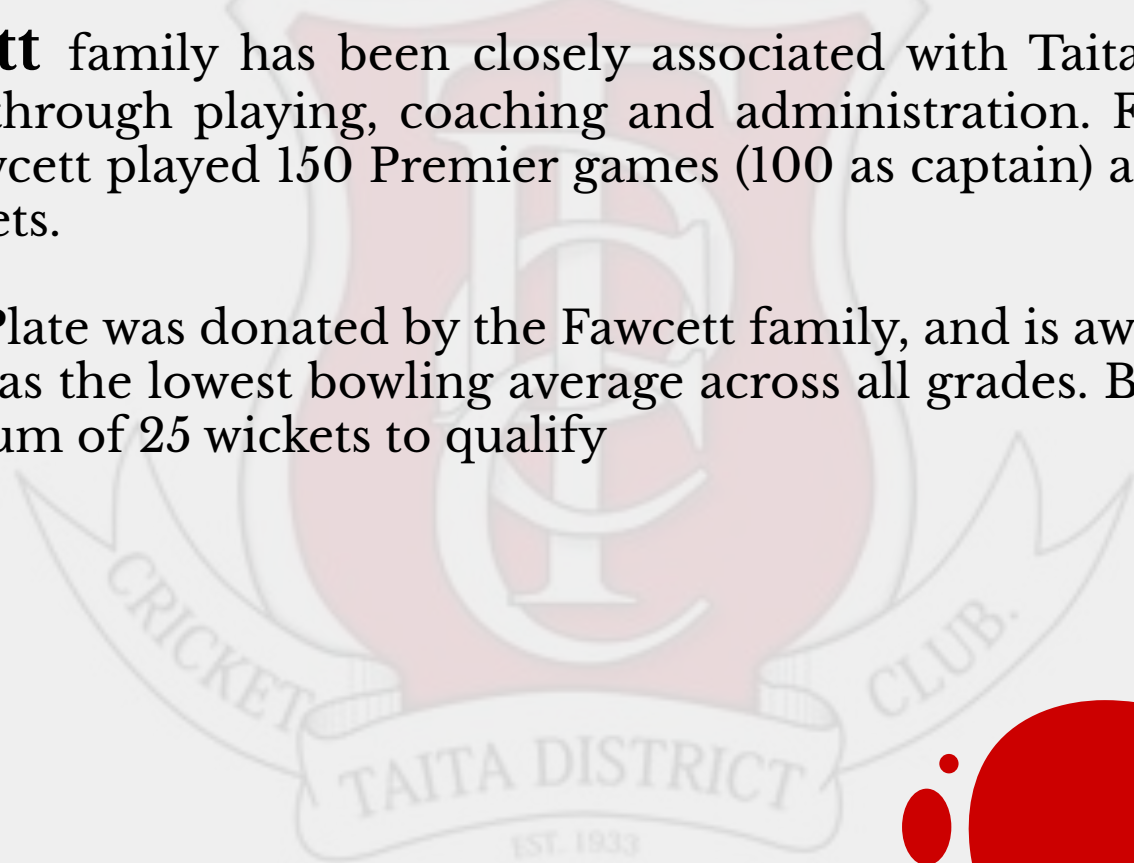


FAWCETT PLATE
