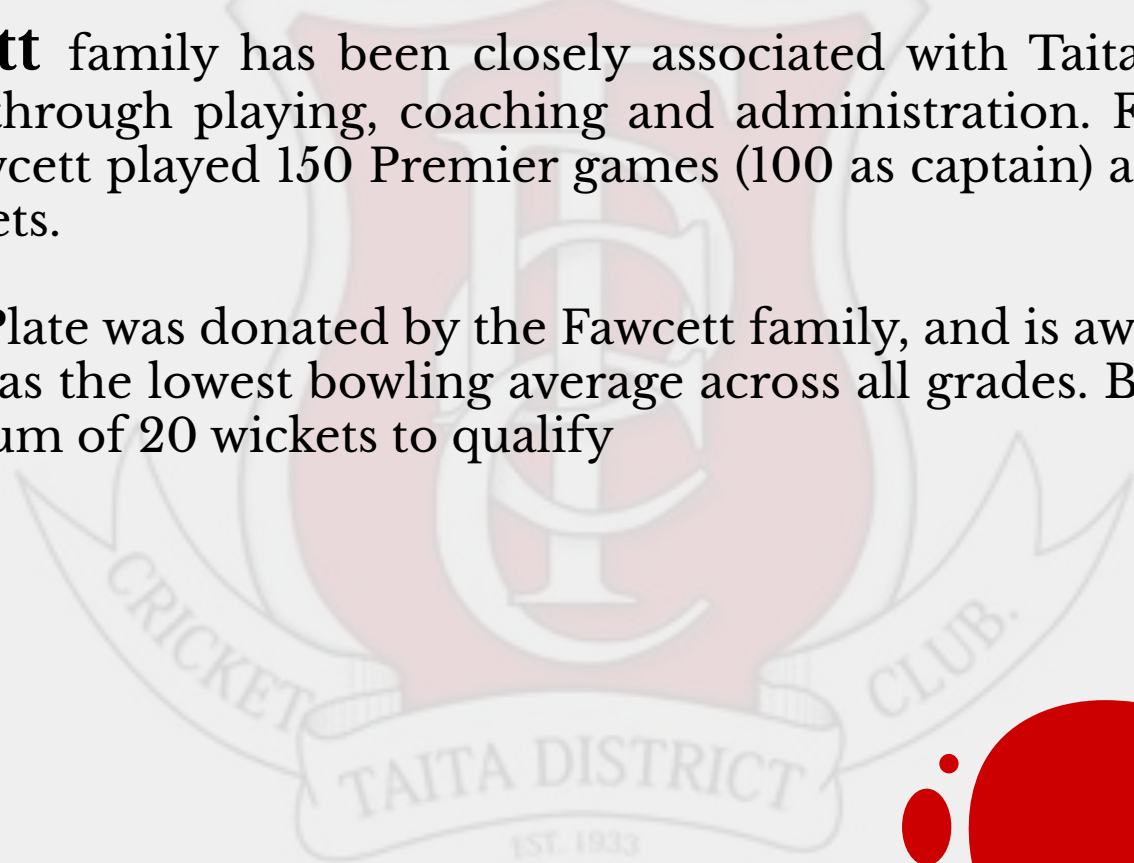


# FAWCETT PLATE

The **Fawcett** family has been closely associated with Taita cricket for many years, through playing, coaching and administration. From 1977 to 1999, Ray Fawcett played 150 Premier games (100 as captain) and took 400 Premier wickets.

The Fawcett Plate was donated by the Fawcett family, and is awarded to the bowler who has the lowest bowling average across all grades. Bowlers must take a minimum of 20 wickets to qualify

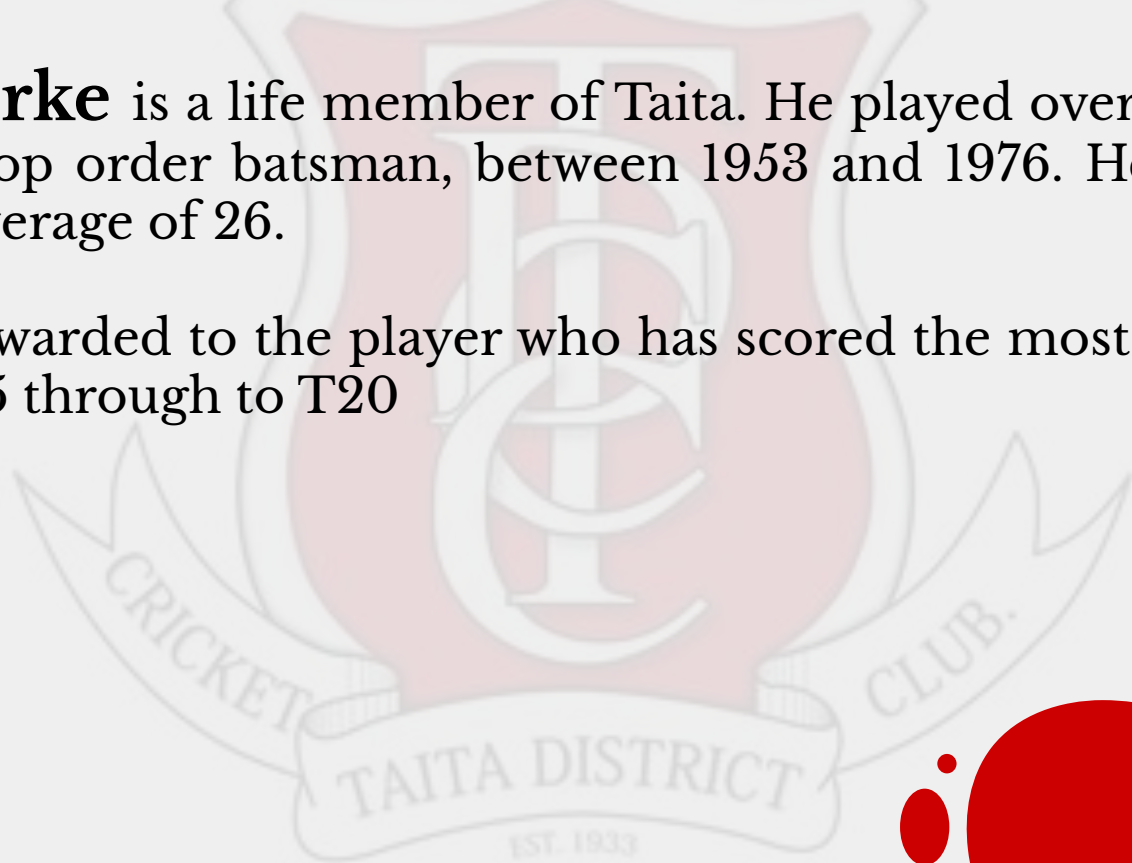

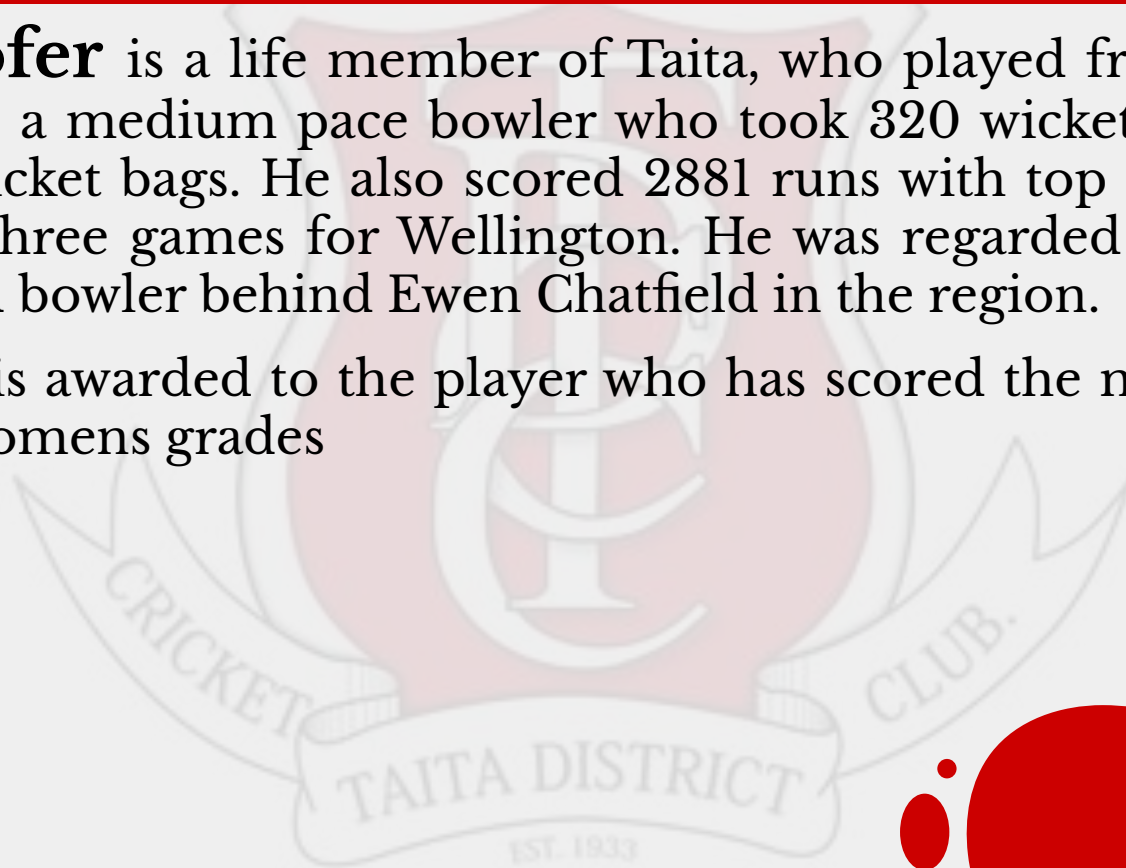


# PHIL SCHOFER TROPHY
